



**PROJECT PROPOSAL:
Visionary Living – Constructing a
Three-Bedroom Home for a Blind
Family**

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Introduction.

This proposal is to seek financial assistance for a crucial project aimed at improving the living conditions of a blind family in our community. The family consists of three visually impaired individuals who face significant challenges in earning a livelihood and currently reside in a deteriorating living environment. This proposal outlines the details of our plan to construct a three-bedroom house, semi-furnished, on their existing land to provide them with a more comfortable and accommodating living space.

Description of Project

This joint initiative by Khidhumaiy Org and Ukulhas Hope aims to construct a three-bedroom house on the family's land, semi-furnished to address their basic needs. Currently, the family's living conditions are inadequate, adversely affecting their well-being and straining familial relationships due to limited space. In collaboration with Dhaaris TV as our media partner, this project seeks to provide a dignified and accessible living environment for the blind family, promoting security and inclusivity.



BENEFICIARIES

Mr. Ali Shameem, a 42-year-old blind individual, faces a challenging living situation with his family and blind siblings. Currently residing in a cramped 3-bedroom house with his wife, two daughters, and three siblings (Shaheen Mohamed (36 Years Old) and Ibrahim Rushdee (34 Years Old), both blind), the living conditions are dire. Additionally, his wife is expecting their third child, adding to the urgency of improving their housing situation.

Ali's eldest daughter, a straight-A student in grade 8, requires a conducive environment for her education and development. The limited space in their current residence poses a significant obstacle. Meanwhile, his blind siblings, both employed at FENAKA Corporation with modest earnings of approximately 7000 Maldivian Rufiyaa, are unable to pursue marriage due to the cramped living conditions.

Ali Shameem, also serving as the Imam of the H.DH. Kurinbee Mosque, has a 3000-square-foot plot of land. Recognizing the pressing need for improved living arrangements, he envisions constructing a new three-bedroom house on this plot to accommodate his growing family and provide a suitable space for his blind siblings.

Addressing the housing challenge is crucial not only for the well-being and comfort of his family but also for the overall quality of life for his blind siblings. The new house would not only offer a larger and more comfortable living space but also create an environment conducive to the personal and professional development of all family members.

As the imminent birth of his third child approaches, and considering the limited living conditions and the aspirations of his siblings, Mr. Ali Shameem faces the urgent task of initiating the construction of a new home on his plot of land. Collaborative efforts, financial planning, and community support may be essential components to successfully improve the living conditions and future prospects for the entire family.

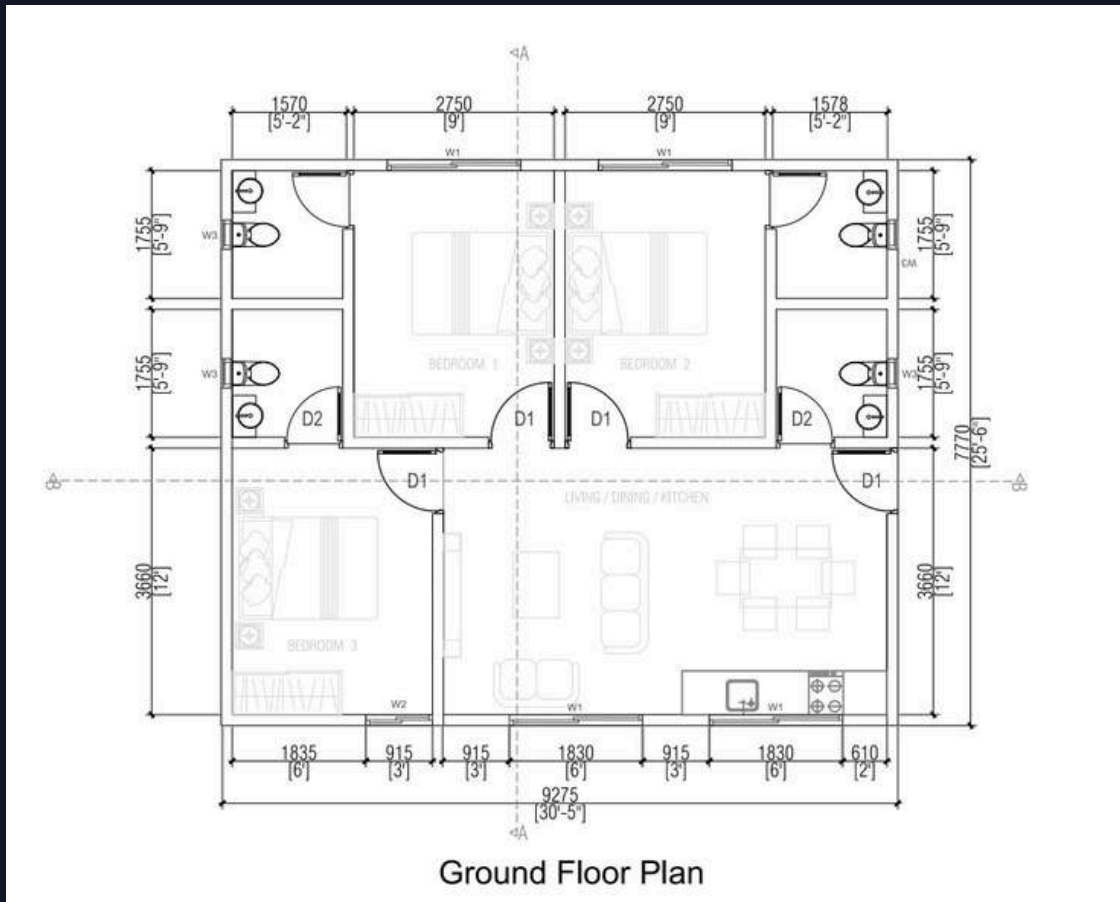

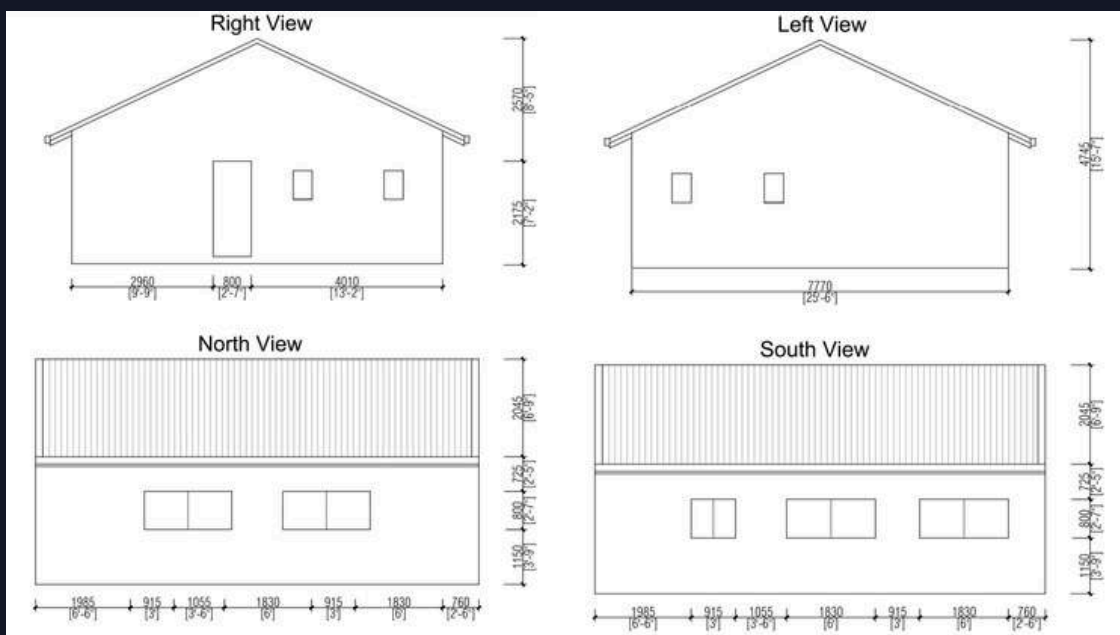
